

Lafayette Parish School System is in south central Louisiana, approximately 55 miles west of the state capital, Baton Rouge. It is the sixth largest and second most diverse school system in the state, with approximately 4,100 employees and nearly 31,000 students—18% of whom have exceptionalities. Lafayette Parish School System's vision is "to continue to provide excellence in education for all students," and their mission states they are "committed to developing productive citizens prepared to compete in a global community."

The Story of Broussard Middle School

Broussard Middle School is one of 11 middle schools within Lafayette Parish School System. The school handbook discusses students' rights and responsibilities, several of which are directly related to a safe learning and educational environment. For example, students have the right to an "environment which promotes learning for all students," and it is their responsibility "to ensure their actions do not disrupt the classroom environment or school activities." Behavioral expectations and consequences for non-compliance are detailed within the 90-page handbook.

The Challenge

Prior to implementing n2y's Positivity, Broussard Middle School faced issues of elopement, and some students were exhibiting self-injurious behavior. In addition, students had difficulties during times of transition and problems communicating feelings in a socially appropriate manner. As a result, the "district's primary goal was to reduce suspensions and expulsions through the implementation of a structure discipline matrix that all staff members must follow when dealing with student disciplinary matters," stated Melinda Perrodin, a special education teacher at Broussard Middle School.

The district had implemented comprehensive staff training on several behavior management programs to target behaviors and provide data for IEP teams. With the training, teachers created their own or customized strategies to use with their students, like visual schedules. Staff were trained on de-escalation techniques to support students with self-regulation skills. And behavior facilitators were employed throughout the district to support a safer inclusive learning environment.

For further progress, Broussard Middle School needed a comprehensive behavior management solution that would:

- Save teachers time in creating customizable evidence-based strategies to reach a wide range of learners' needs
- Assist staff in teaching self-regulation skills
